Call for Abstracts 2nd Meeting on Quantitative Educational Research in Denmark 24-25 November 2022

Dear colleagues,

Following up on last year's initiative by TrygFonden's Centre for Child Research, we invite you to this second meeting on Quantitative Educational Research in Denmark.

The first meeting in 2021 in Vejle was a great way to meet the quantitative educational research community in Denmark, discuss research and develop common research interests. Therefore, we have decided to make the meeting an annual tradition and have formed an organizing committee including a number of the research institutions that took part last year.

The second meeting will take place at Comwell H.C. Andersen Odense on 24-25 November 2022. The conference will start with lunch and a welcome session. After that, we will have paper sessions Thursday afternoon and Friday morning. Thursday evening, we will have dinner together. The meeting will close with lunch Friday at noon.

We encourage everybody to submit abstracts (up to 400 words) or full papers that study education (from early childhood to higher education) using quantitative methods – studies could either focus on education in Denmark or be done by researchers affiliated with Danish research institutions. Contributions that combine quantitative and qualitative methods are also welcome.

We invite submissions of two types of work:

- i) Ordinary paper presentations (30 min presentations and discussions)
- ii) Research proposals and initial work (15 min. presentations and discussions)

Please, indicate which type of presentation you prefer in your submission. Please submit your abstracts/paper to mvandersen@econ.au.dk. The **deadline** for abstracts is **Friday September 16 at 3:00 pm**. Notification messages will be sent out at the end of September. If additional slots are available, we will invite other people to attend the meeting without presenting a paper.

The conference fee is 1,700 DKK, which covers accommodation and meals. Further information is circulated when we open for registration.
